**American Red Cross, Greater Cleveland Chapter
Receives New Arrival**

*Additional Emergency Response Vehicle will provide feeding, transportation
during local, national disasters*

Cleveland, Ohio – May 3, 2006 – The American Red Cross, Greater Cleveland Chapter received a new arrival at its headquarters this week. An Emergency Response Vehicle (ERV) has been added to the Greater Cleveland Chapter's fleet of disaster vehicles. The 2006 ERV, owned by the American National Red Cross in Washington D.C., will respond to both local and national emergencies, including fires, hurricanes, floods and other emergencies.

The new ERV features a larger serving window and a safer seating arrangement. It will help provide feeding and transportation of equipment and supplies during times of disaster. The Chapter also owns another ERV that responded to the September 11, 2001 attacks in New York City and Hurricanes Charley and Frances in Florida in 2004. Currently, there are 271 ERVs in the American Red Cross national fleet.
